He is publisher of HBF Publishing, a print on demand authoring collaboration with Author Solutions, Inc., targeted to African American and Latino readers and writers.

Mr. Rodriguez is the author of the acclaimed *Sacred Fire: The QBR 100 Essential Black Books* (John Wiley & Sons, 1999) and is the editor of the QBR website (www.QBR.com). He has been inducted into the Writer's Hall of Fame at Chicago State University for his pioneering work in the advocacy of African American literature and publishing.
